Parade Line-up Information and Guidelines

Please make sure to share this information with everyone in the entry.

- The parade will be along Chicago Street this year. Line-up will remain in and around the Will County lot at 302 N. Chicago.
- Parade lineup begins at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, November 28th, 2025. All entries should check in by 5 p.m. Parking information will be sent out at a later date to all entries. Only vehicles that are a part of the parade will be able to enter the route, so plan to drop off participants and then park. The parade will begin at 5:30pm.
- Each entry will receive an email prior to the parade with an assigned number and map of line-up. Your assigned number must be displayed in the passenger side window of all parade vehicles.
- All entries should be decorated with lights-this is the Light up the Holidays Parade afterall!
- All floats with children must have at least 2 adults riding on the float for the duration of the event.
- All entries must be pre-registered with a complete application form and designated fees paid.
- Music used on an entry is strongly encouraged and should be stated on the application. Volume must be adjustable, and music must be appropriate for all ages.
- A fire extinguisher is required on each float in case of emergency.
- No candy or materials may be thrown from parade floats or moving vehicles to spectators along the parade route. Walkers should be located on both sides of the floats passing out candy, coupons, or other items.
- Parade participants should not jump on or off moving vehicles during the parade.
- Make sure all decorations on your float are properly secured. Keep extension cords away from wheels.
- Animals in the parade must be stated in the application. All animals must have updated vaccinations and be able to cope with crowds and other animals. Animals must be controlled and always leashed.
- Firearms and toy guns are not allowed except for those used by the Honor Guard.
- The parade organizers may cancel the parade due to inclement or life-threatening weather.
- Parade fees must be paid by November 9, 2025 or the entry will be removed from the parade. Parade fees will not be refunded for any reason.
