Other free Light up the Holidays activities include the North Pole, which will include an iceless skating rink, a large photo opportunity and more free fun. In addition, visitors will enjoy horse-drawn carriage rides, Joliet's tree lighting ceremony, Light up the Holidays Parade, fireworks, and more!

CCP is currently seeking vendors to sell specialty items at the North Pole Christmas Market, such as ornaments, candles, bath and body, holiday floral arrangements, jewelry, and similar items. Due to space constraints, this show will be a juried event. Preference will first and foremost go to vendors selling hand-crafted, personalized, and holiday-themed items.

Applications are due by August 24th and vendors will be notified by September 3rd regarding their status. Potential vendors are asked to submit the application detailing their products, along with labeled photos of the products. Hard copy photos will not be returned.

The Details!

The Christmas Market will take place from 10 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Keep in mind the Joliet Tree Lighting will take place within walking distance at 5:15, and the parade will begin at 5:30 p.m. along Chicago Street. There will be no fee for visitors to enter the market.

Setup for the market begins at 7:30 a.m. There are stairs and an elevator to get to the second level. Vendors can choose one or two 8x12 booth(s). Each booth is \$80 and includes a maximum of 2 tables per booth, chairs, as well as black table covers. Arkas Restaurant Group will provide a maximum of two lunches per vendor business. Vendors may also bring their own table covers. Vendors must remain until the conclusion of the show at 4:30 p.m.

Due to limited space, the North Pole Christmas Market is a juried event. Organizers will review each vendor application along with photos. Vendors with personalized, hand-crafted, and holiday-themed items will be given preference. In an effort to allow for a variety of products to be available on the market, the organizers will limit the number of vendors selling particular items. Organizers have the right to ask vendors to remove items that were not in the application.

If accepted, full payment is due by October 9th. If payment has not been received by then, the vendor will be replaced by one on the waitlist. There will be no refunds for this event. If, for some reason, a vendor is unable to participate, they should notify the organizers immediately to give another vendor the opportunity.
