Parade Line-up Information and Guidelines

Please make sure to share this information with everyone in the entry.

- Parade lineup begins at 4:00pm on Friday, November 25th, 2022. Parking will be available in the parking decks located on Ottawa Street and Scott Street. Only vehicles that are a part of the parade will be able to enter the route, so plan to drop off participants and then park. The parade will begin at 5:30pm.
- Each entry will receive an email prior to the parade with an assigned number and map of lineup. Your assigned number must be displayed in the passenger side window.
- All floats with children must have at least two adults riding on the float for the duration.
- All entries must be pre-registered with a complete application form and designated fees turned paid.
- Music used on an entry is strongly encouraged and should be stated on the application. Volume must be adjustable, and music must be appropriate for all ages.
- We encourage a fire extinguisher on each float in case of emergency.
- No candy or materials may be thrown from parade floats or moving vehicles to spectators along the parade route. Walkers should be located on both sides of the floats passing out candy, coupons, or other items.
- Parade participants should not jump on or off moving vehicles during the parade.
- Make sure all decorations on your float are properly secured. Keep extension cords away from wheels.
- Animals in the parade must be stated in the application. All animals must have updated vaccinations and be able to cope with crowds and other animals. Animals must be controlled and leashed at all times.
- Firearms and toy guns are not allowed except for those used by the Color Guard. The parade organizers may cancel the parade due to inclement or life-threatening weather.
